This door to door service supports those who are stuck for transport and need to get to local destinations within Stratford District.

All the vehicles are fully accessible. This scheme operates South of Stratford on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays between about 9.30am and 2.30pm. It is open to those who

- Have a genuine need for local transport
- Cannot access public transport because of mobility problems
- Live in a rurally isolated location with no other form of transport available

Shipston Link

Running since 1986, Shipston Link offers a variety of services covering the villages around Shipston. Most of the services offer a return route from outlying villages into Shipston. All volunteer drivers are ready to address your individual needs. Nine routes are operated weekly, including services to Banbury Chipping Norton and a local service which operates in and around Shipston. You are eligible to travel free if you hold the National Bus Pass.

Back and 4th Transport

B&4th specialises in providing transport to community, voluntary and social organisations based within the Stratford District. B&4th have 4 fully wheelchair accessible minibuses available to hire. To be eligible, you or your organisation must fall into one of the following categories

- Be rurally isolated with little or no access to public transport
- Be elderly
- Be registered as disabled

B&4th can also offer a transport service to individual wheelchair users to access health related appointments or for social purposes.
